- Contributing to the development and delivery of health and safety training. Providing coaching and on-the-job health and safety training to project staff.
- Contracting external service providers, as required, to provide expert and specialist services which address identified needs and risks, managing external providers in line with Rio Tinto procurement requirements and ensuring value for money.
- Implementing contractor management standards and procedures to ensure contractors comply with Rio Tinto and statutory HSE standards and requirements, conducting contractor pre-qualification and performance audits.
- Conducting investigations into incidents and near misses.
 Establishing facts, identifying causes, presenting findings, and recommending corrective actions.

- Ability to work productively in a multi-language, cross cultural environment.
- Practical problem-solving skills in researching and resolving HSE issues with the ability to develop solutions to nonstandard problems.
