Programme Delivery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Have consideration for the overall student experience of the course, including welcoming and integrating each new cohort ❖ Working with the Events and Office Manager at WTC, help organise GDSM-specific Mini-Residentials which also enable the deepening of the worshipping and learning community ❖ Arrange and lead additional student connection opportunities to help foster community within each cohort ❖ Be available as an additional point of contact for GDSM module lecturers
Student Recruitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ With Comms teams at Fusion and WTC, deliver and develop promotional strategies for 2021 and 2022 intakes ❖ Directly promote the course to Church Leaders and Student Workers and lead the Fusion team in doing likewise ❖ Help organise and participate in promotional activities and events ❖ With the Dean of Postgraduate Studies, be available to speak and pray with potential students for the programme as part of the student's discernment process and, where appropriate, engage with church referees ❖ Work with HDs on streamlined and well-communicated student recruitment
Communications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Develop and implement a GDSM programme communications strategy in conjunction with the Communications team at WTC and the respective Hub Directors (HDs) ❖ Address potential student enquiries in a professional, friendly and efficient manner, liaising with HDs who could also be meeting with the same potential students ❖ Help develop links with feeder churches / networks in liaison with Hub Directors ❖ Ensure details of engagement with these feeder churches / networks are updated in CDMS system in conversation with the HD ❖ Attend select national events as requested, e.g. LAUNCH, Wildfires

Provide, with the HD, pastoral support including prayer ❖ Have a presence at WTC Residentials as a point person for students for pastoral connection, discussion of student ministry aspects of the course etc.
